




First Things First: REGISTER

Save your spot by registering as a Consignor at the event(s) you prefer.





STEP #1 Gather





Kids Grow Fast!

Each child cycles through a wardrobe every 6 months. So, if you're feeling like you have lots of outgrown clothes in your home, you're not alone!

STEP #2 Soft





Keep | Toss | Sell

It's okay to **KEEP** the items that you just aren't ready to part with yet. **TOSS** the items that are too well-loved (stains, missing pieces, or are not working).

SELL the items that meet these 4 C's:

CLEAN

The newer it looks, the better it sells. Check carefully for stains and holes in clothing. Clean all clothing and non-clothing items thoroughly.

CURRENT

Sell warm weather clothing and shoes at our Spring/Summer sale. Sell cold weather items at our Fall/Winter sale. Shoppers love current styles that are in fashion.

COMPLETE

Be sure all parts & pieces are present before you tag items. Shoppers want to open their items when they get home and find everything in working order.

COMPLIANT

Important Safety Guidelines apply to car seats, cribs, infant equipment & toys. All of the Recalls & Safety Standards are listed at **jbfsale.com** for you to check each of your items before you sell.



Where to Create Your Tags

Now that your items are inspected and bundled, it's time to log in to your IBF Profile and enter your tag data.

A check mark here will allow your item to sell at 50% off on Half Price Day


A check mark here will allow your item to be donated if unsold

Print Your Tags

Print tags on 8.5"x11" white cardstock. Tags print 9 per page.

Preparing Your Items & Attaching Tags

Now that your JBF tags are printed, cut them apart and sort them by gender, type, and size to make this step go smoother.



Gather these supplies:

- · computer or mobile phone
- printer (or send to office store)
- white card stock only please
- safety pins or tagging gun
- hangers (child and adult)

- clear ziploc bags
- clear packing tape
- · hole punch
- zip-ties
- scissors or paper cutter

ATTACHING TAGS

- Make sure tag is attached securely so it won't fall off.
- Secure all pieces together so they won't separate & always tape bags closed
- Hats and Accessories: Attach the tag directly to the fabric with a safety pin
- ZIP-TIE tags directly to toys this is one of the easiest and most secure ways to attach a tag















STEP #4 Dep





CLOTHING

Watch all JBF prep videos **HERE**

The best way to learn is to take a few minutes to watch our videos.

We promise it will make everything easier!



Hanger Direction

Be sure the hanger hook opens to the left, like a question mark. Attach JBF tag to top right of item.

ALL clothing must be on hangers. Attach JBF tag with safety pin or tagging gun.



Hanging pants or shorts to hanger

Must be attached to the TOP of the hanger.

Go through the MIDDLE of BOTH areas of the waistband to keep the pants from gaping and sliding to the bottom.

Clip hangers are also great - you can sometimes get them free from dept. stores



Tagging Gun - SEE TAGGING GUN GUIDE HERE

Place the tag gun through a raised lip at the INSIDE EDGE of fabric, along the neck area. Don't go all the way through the back of the fabric or you will make a hole in the clothing. Do NOT place tag in armpit area.

Before punching the gun, check to make sure the needle is weaved through the thick seam area and no part of the needle is showing through the back of the shirt.

Hang the following items ON hangers:

- All Blankets
- Swaddle Wraps
- Changing Table Covers
- Mattress Protectors
- All Sheets
- Towels



Accessories

Use clear bags to bundle sets of socks, bows, accessories, and infant items.
Display neatly so shopper can see well.


Tape JBF tag inside or outside so it's easy to see and tape bag closed.



SHOES

Hole-punch your tag and use a zip-tie to secure shoes and tag together. For shoes that can't be zip-tied, use a safety pin or place in clear bag. Most shoes have a spot to zip-tie – get creative.

Remember to reinforce the top of the tag with tape before you hole punch



Hanging Multiple Items on a Hanger

For sets, make sure the items are THE SAME SIZE and all pieces are secured together and to the hanger.

Safety Pin through all the pieces and around the hanger to give support and prevent a tear.

STEP #5 DO CONTINUES.



You did it!

Now that your items are tagged, you'll want to pack items **organize by type and size,** so that Drop Off is easy and fast.

Consignors can select which day on registration form:

DROP OFF: Sunday 4/14 5-9pm AND Monday 4/15 9am-12pm

Check in.. Plan for 60-minutes to drop off your items. Longer if you have 300+ items to drop off.

Please refer to waiver agreement if you have 300+ items.

Your first stop will be Clothing Inspection. Leave your clothing items here while you place all of your non-clothing items where they belong on the sales floor. Then, return to Clothing Inspection to pick up your items. You'll hang all clothing in gender/size areas on the racks. Please note there is a limit on junior clothing items listed below.

All items that a child sits in, is carried in, or sleeps in will be inspected at our Safety & Recalls Station.

For your Large Items, we will attach a yellow ticket to the items which makes it easier for shoppers to purchase your items during the sale.

Craft kits should remain unfinished

USED COLORING BOOKS No coloring/activity books that have any pages used or colored

BEDDING LARGER
THAN FULL

Only crib sheets, twin and full size blankets, bedspreads, comforters

SINGLE ONESIES

Onesies must have multiples or be made into an outfit

MISMATCHED SIZES

Outfits must be same size to pair together

Limit of 300 Items. Each tag equals 1 item.

20 JUNIOR GIRL ITEMS

1 tag equals 1 item for a total of 20 JR Girl Clothing items. Sizes 0-13, XS-XL Teen Brands Only

20 JUNIOR BOY ITEMS

1 tag equals 1 item for a total of 20 JR Boy Clothing Items. Sizes S-XL, Teen Brands Only

NEW ITEMS

1 tag equals 1 item. Only 3 items that are brand new, exact same size, color, shape etc. will be allowed on the sales floor. This applies to all items including but not limited to clothing, toys, books, etc.

We appreciate gently used items and even new with tags that your child/ren may not have worn, just no more than 3 of the exact same item without prior approval.
